When to discontinue Level B PPE:

• Discontinue PPE 10 days from the client's last date of exposure.

When to discontinue Level C PPE:

- **COVID-positive clients with symptoms:** Discontinue 10 days after symptom onset, *and* resolution of fever for at least 24 hours (without use of fever-reducing medications), *and* improvement of other symptoms. (Some clients with severe illness may remain contagious up to 20 days after symptom onset; consider consultation with infection control experts.)
- Asymptomatic clients who have tested positive: Discontinue 10 days after the date of their first positive test.

Collaborate with your office if you think additional protection is needed.
